



Background

Religion was going through a dark period in the United States in the early 1800's

The state of churches in the early 1800's was much different than now. Virtually every church subscribed to their own creed. In many cases, they required members to sign the creed. There were many instances where two nearby churches of the same "denomination," but slightly different creeds, would not recognize each other's members because they had not signed "their creed." Numerous people, (Thomas Jefferson, Thomas Paine, and Benjamin Franklin, to name a few) made statements about the poor state of the clergy and doctrines promoted by the churches of that time.

Joseph Smith Jr.

Through divine revelation, restored the church from 1830 to 1836. Explanation given in 1843 - "I cannot believe in any of the creeds of the different denominations, because they all have some things in them I cannot subscribe to, though all of them have some truth... I believe the bible, as it ought to be, as it came from the pen of the original writers." He did write a letter to John Wentworth that included a short synopsis of beliefs from the Scriptures:

An Epitome of Faith and Doctrine

We believe in God the Eternal Father, and in his Son Jesus Christ, and in the Holy Ghost. (Many scriptural references)

We believe that men will be punished for their own sins, and not for Adam's transgressions.

We believe that through atonement of Christ all mankind may be saved by obedience to the laws and ordinances of the gospel.

We believe that these ordinances are, first, faith in the Lord Jesus Christ; second, repentance; third, baptism by immersion for the remission of sins; fourth, laying on of hands for the gift of the Holy Ghost.

- Faith first: Eph 4:5, Mat 5:4, Mat 9:28, Mat 9:35, Mat 15:27, Mat 17:19-20, Mat 21:19, Mark 2:5, Mark 16:15, Luke 16:10-13, Acts 8:12, Acts 18:8, Rom 4:13-16, **BoM** Helaman 5:96, 3 Nephi 4:50, 3 Nephi 8:8, 3 Nephi 12:32
- Repentance before baptism: Mat 3:28, Mat 4:16, Mat 7:9, Mark 6:10-12, Mark 16:15-16, Luke 13:2-5, Luke 15, Acts 2:37-41, Acts 3:18-21, Acts 8:34-39, **BoM** Moroni 8:9-29 (includes no infant baptism)
- Baptism by immersion: Rom 6:3-5, Col 2:12, Greek *Baptisma* (Mat 3:7, 20:22, 20:23, 21:25; Mark 1:4, 10:38, 10:39, 11:30; Luke 3:3, 7:29, 12:50, 20:4; Acts 1:22, 10:37, 13:24, 18:25, 19:3, 19:4; Rom 6:4; Eph 4:5; Col 2:12; 1 Peter 3:21) and *Baptizo* (Mat 3,

20, 28, Mark 1, 6, 7; Luke 3, 7, 11, 12; John 1, 3, 4, 10; Acts 1, 2, 8, 9, 10, 16, 18, 19, 22; Rom 6; 1 Cor 1, 10, 12, 15; Gal 3). Commentary: *Baptisma* is always used for immersion (even in non-biblical Greek documents). *Bapto* means dip and never used to refer to baptism (i.e. conversion of faith).

- o Book of Mormon: 3 Nephi 5:23-26 [23] And he said unto them, On this wise shall ye baptize; and there shall be no disputations among you. [24] Verily I say unto you, that whoso repenteth of his sins through your words, and desireth to be baptized in my name, on this wise shall ye baptize them: Behold, ye shall go down and stand in the water, and in my name shall ye baptize them. [25] And now behold, these are the words which ye shall say, calling them by name, saying: Having authority given me of Jesus Christ, I baptize you in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost. Amen. [26] And then shall ye immerse them in the water, and come forth again out of the water.

- Baptism of the Holy Spirit: Acts 2:37-41, Hebrews 10:16-22 (Commentary: In Judaism, the heart held wisdom, and wisdom can only come from God through His Holy Spirit. The phrase, "having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience," refers to the Holy Spirit pouring on evil hearts and not the sprinkling of water). **BoM** 3 Nephi 4:50

We believe that a man must be called of God by "prophecy, and by laying on of hands" by those who are in authority to preach the gospel and administer the ordinances thereof.

- Called of God: Deu 18:1-7, Exo 19:3-6 (repeated in 1 Peter 2:4-9), Num 16:1-3, 10-11, 20-21 (God's response to self-chosen priesthood, also Psalm 106:13-17), 1 Saml 16:1-13, 2 Chr 26:3-4, 17-21, Psalm 105:26,

Isaiah 51:2, Mat 12:17-18, John 15:15-16, Acts 9:3-12 (Paul called as Aaron), Acts 9:15, 22:10-14, Heb 7:1-2, 8-11, 1 Cor 7:17-24, 1 Cor 12:13-28 (God "sets"), Heb 5:4-10, 1 Peter 2:4-9, Rev 17:14, **BoM** Mosiah 11:18, Alma 8:10

- Laying on of Hands:

- o Ordaining: ("semikah" - "This is my property, which I dedicate to God."). All Jewish religious leaders who were not Aaronic priests (Kohanim) had to be ordained before they were permitted to perform certain judicial functions and to decide practical questions in Jewish law. The Bible relates that Moses ordained Joshua by placing his hands on him, thereby transferring a portion of his spirit [Holy Spirit] to Joshua (Num. 27:22, 23; Deut. 34:9). Num 11:16-17, Num 11:24-25, Num 27:18-23, Deu 34:9, 1 Sam 16:11-13, Acts 6:2-6, Acts 13:2-3, 1 Tim 4:11-16, **BoM** Alma 4:1, Moroni 2:1-3, Moroni 3:1-3
- o Baptism of the Holy Ghost (Gift to disciples): Exo 24:3-8, Ezek 39:21-22, John 7:39, Acts 8:14-17, Acts 19:4-6, Heb 6:1-3, **BoM** Moroni 2:1
- o Administration of the sick: Mark 6:4-5, Luke 4:40, Luke 13:12-13, Acts 28:8, **BoM** Mormon 4:86-87
- o Blessing of children: Mat 19:13-15, **BoM** 3 Nephi 8:12-26

We believe in the same organization that existed in the primitive church; viz., apostles, prophets, pastors, teachers, evangelists, etc.

- God's priesthood existed before Aaron: Gen 14:18, Exo 3:1 & 18:12, Exo 12:21, Exo 19:20-22, Psa 110:4, Col 1:12-19, Heb 7:11-12, Heb 7:22-24
- Prophets: Acts 13:1, 1 Cor 12:28-29, Eph 4:11-12, **BoM** 1 Nephi 1:3, 1 Nephi 1:162, 1 Nephi 5:226

- **Apostles:** 1 Cor 12:28-29, Eph 4:11-12, **BoM** Moroni 2:2
- **Evangelists:** Eph 4:11-12
- **High Priests:** Lev 21:10, Num 35:25, 2 Kings 12:10, Neh 3:1, Hag 1:1, Mat 26:3, Heb 5:10, **BoM** Alma 10:1
- **Bishops:** Phil 1:1, 1 Tim 3:1-2
- **Seventy:** Num 11:16, Luke 10:1
- **Elders:** Exo 12:21, **BoM** Alma 2:11, JewishEncyclopedia.com - The position and function of the elder are nowhere clearly defined. "What there was of permanent official authority lay in the hands of the elders and heads of the houses; Together with the priests, they sometimes participated in certain sacrificial rites (Lev. iv. 15, ix. 1).

We believe in the gift of tongues, prophecy, revelation, visions, healing, interpretation of tongues, etc.

We believe the Bible to be the word of God as far as it is translated correctly; we also believe the Book of Mormon to be the word of God.

- 1 John 4:1-3 [1] Beloved, believe not every spirit, but try the spirits whether they are of God; because many false prophets are gone out into the world. [2] Hereby know ye the Spirit of God; Every spirit that confesseth that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is of God; [3] And every spirit that confesseth not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is not of

God; and this is that spirit of antichrist, whereof ye have heard that it should come; and even now it is already in the world.

We believe all that God has revealed, all that he does now reveal, and we believe that he will yet reveal many great and important things pertaining to the kingdom of God.

We believe in the literal gathering of Israel and in the restoration of the Ten Tribes, that Zion will be built upon this continent, that Christ will reign personally upon the earth, and that the earth will be renewed and receive its paradisaic glory.

- In the early 1800's, this statement was considered to be an impossible occurrence. The gathering and restoration of Israel started in the 1880's through 1948 when the country of Israel was officially recognized.

We claim privilege of worshipping Almighty God according to the dictates of our consciences, and allow all men the same privilege, let them worship how, where, or what they may.

We believe in being subject to kings, presidents, rulers, and magistrates, in obeying, honoring, and sustaining the law.

We believe in being honest, true, chaste, benevolent, virtuous, and in doing good to all

men; indeed we may say that we follow the admonition of Paul, "we believe all things, we hope all things," we have endured many things, and hope to be able to endure all things. If there is anything virtuous, lovely, or of good report or praiseworthy, we seek after these things.

Sacraments and Ordinances

Patriarchal Blessing: Gen 14:19; Mercer Dictionary of the Bible: Blessings were also requested by and given through power-filled mediators, family heads, priests, kings, and prophets. Patriarchs blessed their heirs by both the spoken word and the laying on of hands (Gen 27:1-45; 48:1-20).

Sacraments and Ordinances

- **Baptism.** Only mode is by immersion. Candidate needs faith and true repentance. At least 8 years old.
- **Baptism of the Holy Spirit** (confirmation) with laying on of hands.
- **Communion.** Witness that we will keep God's commandments. Only served to those who have been baptized.
- **Administration of the sick.** Uses laying on of hands. Given to all that ask.
- **Blessing of children** (under 8 years old). Uses laying on of hands. Parents may be members or non-members.
- **Priesthood ordination.** Uses laying on of hands (i.e. Semikah in the Old Testament, Num 27:23).
- **Marriage.** Only between one man and one woman. Mark 10:6-7, 1 Cor 7:2-4
- **Patriarchal Blessing.** Gives an authoritative, priestly blessing. Blessing may include comfort, admonition, counsel, redirection, reconstruction, and/or benediction. Typically given once to those 15+ years old.

Key differences of the RLDS / Restoration and LDS Church

(JofD=Journal of Discourses; D&C=Doctrine & Covenants). Brigham Young introduced the following doctrines into the LDS church (not supported by the RLDS / Restoration Branches):

- **Changeable God** "the God I serve is progressing eternally." (JofD, Vol 11, p120).
- **Different Gospel** – Adam not made of this earth (JofD, vol 3, p319), God was a man (JofD, Vol 4, p218), and multiple gods (LDS D&C 121)
- **Jesus' atonement was imperfect** (JofD, vol 4, p219-220)
- **Man may become Gods** (JofD, vol7, p333)
- **Celestial Marriage** (marriage that extends after death) (JofD, vol 15, p133, LDS D&C 132)
- **Polygamy** (BoM states it is an abomination-twice)
- **Adam was God** (JofD, vol 1, p50, manuscript 10/8/1861)
- **False prophecies** Brigham Young never claimed to be a prophet chosen by God, but declared his word equaled Scripture (JofD, Vol 13, p264)
- **Different Christ – not a virgin birth** (JofD, Vol 1, p50)
- **Heavenly Mother** (JofD, vol 9, p286; JofD, vol 11, p122)
- **Exaltation** – priesthood is mandatory and progresses through tiers of offices in order to achieve the highest realm in Heaven (and become a god)(JofD, vol 4, p194-199)
